

We just finished Christmas in July with OCC Shoeboxes, which only helps me feel like August is the beginning of a new year! I've always felt like "back to school" was a second New Years. August gives us a fresh new beginning for several of our programs and ministries after a summer break and with our folks back in the swing of things after summer vacations.

A new school year and a new season of ministry is a great time to refresh ourselves on our church's discipleship strategy with **a new sermon series**. Our church's missional mandate for "loving God, loving people, and making disciples of Jesus from



all generations" is accomplished through our missional map, or what we call *The Disciple's Path*: Come to Worship, Grow in Groups, Serve in Love, and Go & Tell. Join us beginning August 6 for this journey of discovering what each of these means and how they help us as a church to follow in the footsteps of Jesus.

For those who are new to the FBC Thomson family, either as new members or as someone interested in becoming part of our church family, these messages will be a helpful exploration of who we are as a church. Then, on **August 27**, you can discover more about our church and how to become a member at our **Next Steps Luncheon** after worship. We will provide a free lunch for you and your family and offer childcare as we spend time exploring more about our church and how you can find your place of service here. Please contact the church office and let us know if you are planning to attend.

August 6 will be a big day here at FBC Thomson! In addition to beginning our new sermon series, we will have the joy of presenting Bibles to our rising 1st graders, all children and youth will be promoted to their new Sunday School classes, and all children and their families are invited to stay for a Pizza with the Pastors lunch in the Fellowship Hall. But we will also have the sacred privilege and duty to nominate men to serve in our **Deacon Ministry** for a three-year term. All members of the church should have received a packet in the mail about our deacon selection process and a list of men (resident members, 25 years of age and older, who have been members of the church at least two years) to pray through and use to guide you in who you feel led to nominate on August 6. Our Deacon Ministry is a vital part of how we love one another as a church family as they lead our church through their example of service, worship, and prayer. Please make this a priority in your prayers as we nominate these men, as they prayerfully decide whether to keep their name on the selection ballot and as we finalize that selection process on September 10.

Finally, let me encourage you to use this "second New Year" as a chance to renew your commitment to Sunday School, corporate worship, your financial stewardship to God, AND joining us on **Wednesday nights** for fellowship supper and truly wonderful programs for all ages. Our TinyKID and TeamKID ministries for children, Elevate at the Warehouse for youth, and The Disciple's Pathway study for adults in the Fellowship Hall are second-to-none. I'm especially excited to begin a new study on the books of the Bible I'm calling "Route 66: A Road Trip through the Bible." Although it will be a lengthy study through the Bible, each week will be like a standalone lesson. So don't feel stressed if you miss a week or two, or if you want to jump in later on. Each week will have value by itself. But I do hope to see you every Wednesday night!


