As we move into September, I'm grateful for the many ways God is at work in our church family. Let me share a few important updates and upcoming opportunities.

Church Directory Update—Work is already underway on updating our church directory! We are currently incorporating the beautiful photos that Maggie Allen took on Mother's Day. If an updated picture is needed for your family, Christy will be reaching out to you directly. In the next couple of weeks, you'll also notice a section on the Connect Card where you can let us know what information you would like included in the directory—such as home phone, cell phone, email address, mailing address, etc. Your input will help us ensure the directory is accurate, helpful, and a great resource for our church family.

Deacon Selection— At the conclusion of worship on Sunday, September 7, our church will prayerfully select new deacons to serve our congregation. The names of the men on the front of the Cornerstone have agreed to serve if chosen. We will be selecting 9 men, 8 will serve a 3 year term and the 9th will fulfill the final year of Coach Paul Leroy's unfulfilled term. Please continue to lift up this process in prayer, asking God to guide our hearts as we affirm those who will serve.

Committee Budget Workshop—All committees and ministry teams responsible for budgeted ministries are reminded of the Committee Budget Workshop on Sunday, September 21 at 5 PM. Ministry leaders and committee chairs should have already received budget request packets. This is an important step in planning well for the year ahead.

Mission Georgia Offering—From September 7–14, we will join with churches across Georgia for the Mission Georgia Week of Prayer and Offering. This year's theme is "Missions In Motion." Our church's offering goal is \$6,000. These gifts directly support gospel-centered ministries across our state, such as foster care, human trafficking rescue, literacy missions, refugees, and more. For All Generations Campaign—Finally, I want to share an encouraging update on our For All Generations campaign. We are over one-third of the way to our goal, while only six months into this three-year journey. We are far ahead of expectations! Several people and families have already completed their commitments—and some have even exceeded them. I want to encourage everyone to remain faithful in fulfilling what you have committed to the church. For those who have not yet begun giving toward your commitment, now is the perfect time to start. And for new members or those who didn't make a commitment earlier—it's not too late! Commitment cards are available in the Sanctuary every Sunday and in the Atrium during the week.

When will we see work begin? The architects are still working on the drawings we need, but we are hopeful to receive those soon and begin making decisions on which areas of renovation will happen first. Thank you for your continued prayers and generosity as we invest in ministry spaces that will serve our church for all generations.

Sunday School Weekend—September 6 and 7!
