We've been looking at our church's vision these past few weeks, especially our discipleship map, "The Disciple's Path." Basically, we believe that every growing and thriving follower of Jesus should be actively engaged in these four areas:

• Coming to Christ in Worship—both personally and corporately in Sunday morning worship. We need to worship God with other believers.

This month in worship we will have the joy of helping a family dedicate themselves and their child to the Lord. We will be blessed on September 3rd to have **Jeff Harris** in the pulpit while I'm on the Gatlinburg mission trip with our youth and college students. Please pray for Jeff and be there to hear what God has to say through his message. I will finish this current sermon series on September 10th and begin **a new series on Jesus' I AM statements** in John's Gospel.

• Growing into Christlikeness in Small Groups—we believe the best way for you to grow spiritually is through Bible study and prayer in relationship with other Christians. Our Sunday School and other small group Bible studies are designed to help you connect with others and with God's Word!

Please join us for the **Big Breakfast** on September 10th in the Fellowship Hall. If you don' have a Sunday School class, that's all the more reason to be there and get connected! On Wednesdays at 7, we are learning about all 66 books of the Bible in *Route 66: A Road Trip thru the Bible*. We've had over 66 people there each week! But the great thing about this study is that every week is a stand alone lesson, so if you've not been yet, please come! If you miss a week, you won't be lost.

• Serving Christ Out of Love—God has shaped every Christian for service in His church. Being a good steward of our time, treasure, and talents allows us to give and serve in the unique ways God has blessed and shaped us. We want to help you get involved in serving through FBC Thomson.

On September 10th, at the close of worship, we will be electing 9 men to serve as **deacons** (8 for a three year term, and one to complete a unfinished term for 2 years). Be prayerful about this process. These men help lead us in service as a church.

Our church's 2024 **budget planning** process begins this month. Pray for wisdom as we seek to steward God's resources for ministry next year. If you are on a committee or in an area of ministry that has budget planning responsibilities, please be at the budget workshop at 5 PM on September 17th.

The **Committee on Committees** is also beginning its work of making sure our committees and ministry teams are staffed for 2024. In the first two Sundays of this month, you'll have a chance in worship to indicate what committees you might be interested in serving on. Our committees function like ministry teams and help us carry out the work of the church. Prayerfully consider where God might have you serve.

• **Go for Christ to Make Disciples**—The Great Commission is our purpose as a church and as Christians. We are to go and tell others the Good News of Jesus and help people follow the path of discipleship we are on.

This month we are emphasizing the **Mission Georgia offering** and week of prayer for Georgia Baptist Missions. On Sunday, September 10th you'll receive a prayer booklet that will help you pray for and understand the areas of need the Mission Georgia offering helps our state mission board address. Our church's goal for the offering is \$3,500 and every dime helps us in reaching people in Georgia for Christ and meet their needs in His name. How would God have you give this year?

Be in prayer for our Gatlinburg Mission Trip in partnership with Smokey Mountain Resort Ministries (SMRM) coming up Labor Day Weekend. First Baptist high school youth and college students will be leading four campground worship services on Sunday for guests, employees, and residents of Gatlinburg. On Saturday, weather permitting, we will canvass the campgrounds and invite folks to worship while they are outside picnicking and watching football. We also have trail maintenance and house cleanup work to do at the ministry center. Then on Sunday afternoon there will be free time for our group in Gatlinburg.

Be in prayer for Cornerstone Preschool starting Tuesday, September 5 after the Labor Day Weekend. Be in prayer for our director, Laura Wall, the teachers, and the children. There are over 80 children in preschool this year, making it the largest preschool group in our preschool's history.
